

Homework

Each week, four days of homework are given to apply concepts from that week's lesson and reinforce the topic.

Parent/Teaching Tip:



- Parents/Teachers should read out instructions to the student.
- Parents/Teachers should help student with sounding out words, naming objects, or identifying letters/numbers.
- This age group can get restless, so it is okay to take a pause to allow students to reset and focus again.
- If a student is getting tired of writing things 5 times, reducing the number is okay, too.

Have your student point and say the numbers below out loud:

Pencil movement for each number is shown below.




Student Goals:


- I will be able to identify, say, and write numbers 26-30


